(PRIYD) PROVIDING RESOURCES & INDEPENDENCE TO YOUTH DEVELOPMENT CHILD AND YOUTH CARE WORKER INTERNAL/EXTERNAL JOB POSTING

This is an hourly position serving clients throughout the Lower Mainland. Individual contracts range from 4 to 5 hours per week. The position reports to the Coordinator, or Supervisor of the PRIYD program.

The PRIYD program provides one to one and group support to children and youth. This is a community access program focusing on functional life skills and community integration. Referrals are from Community Living B.C. and Family Preservation and Reunification Services. We also have some fee for service clients.

DUTIES INCLUDE:

- Supporting children and youth who may have significant developmental delay
- Working with children and youth who have been impacted by family crisis such as: domestic violence, foster placement, parental illness or incapacity
- Utilizing modelling, coaching and counselling assisting children and youth through transitions
- Develop positive and supportive relationships with referred clients, their families and other significant figures in the child/youth's life
- Identify and utilize appropriate community resources and programs as part of a goal oriented plan
- Liaise with social workers, behaviour consultants, educational staff and families as part of an integrated team
- Plan, implement and evaluate service plan goals
- Advocate on behalf of clients and families when appropriate
- Maintain accurate, confidential case notes
- Complete timesheets, billing forms, and progress reports as scheduled

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Two years of post secondary education or training in child/youth care
- Three years experience working with children and youth with behavioural challenges or mental and/or physical disabilities
- Standard First Aid certificate
- Criminal record check is required
- Demonstrated ability to work with hard to reach children, youth and their families
- Ability to identify health and safety issues for children and youth
- Knowledge of child development
