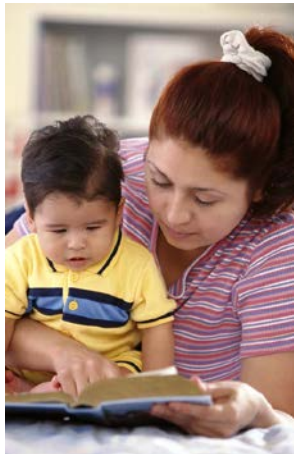


## Volunteer Opportunity Healthy Connections Program

Family Services of Greater Vancouver is a non-profit organization dedicated to strengthening people, families and communities. We provide a diverse range of professional support and counselling services to those who are experiencing challenges in their lives.

We are in need of volunteer child minders to help look after infants from 1 month to 30 months of age, for short periods while the mother attends our Healthy Connections Program. Mother’s individual appointment lasts approximately 60 to 90 minutes. Typically, we schedule up to 4 mothers per day, Monday through Thursday. On Friday, child minders are needed from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. for the Connections Group.

<i>Number of Volunteers needed:</i>	4 – 6
<i>Qualifications sought:</i>	An interest in babies, experience caring for babies, a calm demeanor, good health and ability to lift and carry babies, good problem solving skills and reliable. RCMP records check required at no cost to the volunteer.

<i>Timeframe:</i>	Up to 6 hours per week
<i>Hours preferred:</i>	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
<i>Length of Commitment sought:</i>	Open ended – however, babies need continuity, and it is to their benefit to be cared for by someone who is familiar to them. The group will span 6 to 8 weeks and will have spaces between sequences.
<i>Position Start Date:</i>	As soon as possible.
